Abstract: Maintaining acceptable machine availability and repair costs is a challenge for contractor operations where sophisticated repair support systems may not exist. This study defines the present state-of-the-art in contractor equipment maintenance through on-site interviews with a sample of contractors in Eastern Canada. Differences from traditional company maintenance operations were noted and recommendations to improve maintenance strategies have been made.
